STANDING REPORTS

Chancellor's Updates

Dr. Collins gave an update on Gov. Maura Healey's DRIVE legislation which could provide \$400 million in support for institutions that do research. On October 30th he testified in favor of this initiative to a joint committee of the House and Senate that is considering the legislation. Dr. Collins remains optimistic that Umass Chan will receive some funding, however, the amount and timing is still unknown,

Dean and Provost Updates

Dean Flotte thanked Dr. Luzuriaga and the members of the Umass Chan Research Retreat Planning Committee who put together the research retreat on October 28th and 29th. Dr. Gao, the recipient of this year's Chancellor's Medal for Outstanding Scholarship and Research, was unable to attend but delivered an outstanding speech remotely. Dean Flotte recently attended the AAMC annual conference and states that our advocates in the AAMC are optimistic that the Senate and House committees that handle NIH appropriations will approve budgets with some increase.

Vice Provost for Faculty Affairs Updates

Dr. Ahn gave an update on Interfolio pilot year 1 and feedback that was received from the Interfolio Governance Committee, faculty as well as IT and ACES II. After reviewing the feedback, it was decided that the Interfolio contract would not be renewed effective January 1, 2026.

The Office of Faculty Affairs is working with IT to find two new systems, one for annual performance reviews and one for appointments, promotions and tenure.
